## What is FirstNet?

FirstNet is a cellular network for public safety **only**. The government created FirstNet after events like 9/11 showed privately-owned networks get overwhelmed during emergencies. FirstNet doesn't allow non-public safety users on the network so there's no competition to make calls, send texts, or use the internet. That means during a crisis, you won't see "Call Failed" and your data will continue to work.

## What does this mean for you?

Because your agency is considered public safety you are eligible to get FirstNet! You'll be on a cellular network 100% dedicated to public safety and pay a price set by government. In addition, because the contractor that operates FirstNet for the government is AT&T, your family can be on the same account with a 25% discount!
