

REQUEST FOR WAIVER OF LATE LIST PENALTIES

As provided by North Carolina General Statute 105-307, property must be listed with the assessor within the time allowed by law and failure to list will result in a late filing penalty. Personal Property Listings received after the January 31 filing deadline without approved extension, as well as discovered property, are considered late and receive a late filing penalty as provided by North Carolina General Statute 105-312(h).

Any listing received after prescribed deadlines may request a waiver and should show good cause for late filing. Determination of good cause is made on a case-by-case basis, considering all pertinent facts and circumstances. A late filed listing and request for late list penalty waiver may be presented to the Harnett County Board of Equalization and Review for consideration.
